1. Status of measurement infrastructure

Reynaldo has finished the cron job for email notifications of unresponsive nodes, and has added the actual (experimental) sample rate to the plots. In addition, Reynaldo has been learning the tools to plot delay.

2. Update from CEN

Expect the equipment to be moved to Hartford office and begin operation in September. Internet2 still targets to get 100Gbps connection working in September or October. Connection to Cambridge (4x10Gbps channels) to be ready in September.
